Geoffrey Chaucer (?1340- 1400) is often called the founder of English literary language and poetry. He was a first medieval poet known as the "father of English poetry" whose burial in Westminster Abbey marks the beginning of the poet's corner. He was a well-educated man who read Latin, and studied French and Italian poetry, but he was not interested only in books. He traveled and made good use of his eyes, and the people whom he describes are just like living people. The Canterbury Tales/1384/ total altogether 17,000 lines – about half of Chaucer's literary production. Collections of stories, both secular and sacred, articulated into a general framework, had been numerous and popular in the Middle Ages and early Italian Renaissance, which inherited the taste for them, had enlarged their scope and humanized their content. Chaucer developed the frame-story of the journey, dialogue, and interactions of Canterbury pilgrims to such a degree that the frame itself approximated the form of an organized plot.

Pyramids of Giza. The development of the pyramids reached its climax during the Forth Dynasty in the famous triad of great pyramids at Giza. All of them are of the familiar smooth-sided shape. They originally had been faced with stone, which disappeared except near the top of the pyramid of Chefren. Each of the three pyramids differs slightly from the others in details of design and construction. The earliest and the largest among them is the pyramid of Cheops, with the burial chamber in the center of the structure. For Mycerinus, Chefren's successor, was the third and the smallest pyramid built.

Several smaller pyramids and a large number of mastabas of the high officials are placed around the three great ones. The world has always wondered at the size and technical accomplishment of these pyramids.

Portraits. Apart from its architectural achievements – the chief glory of Egyptian art – during the Old Kingdom are the portrait statues recovered from funerary temples and tombs. One of the finest is that of Chefren from the valley temple. It is carved of diorite – a stone of extreme hardness. It shows the king enthroned with the falcon enfolding his head in its wings. The body is well proportioned and powerfully built, but completely impersonal though the face has some individual features.

1. It's strange that the differences in Britain itself are greater than those between Britain and other English-speaking countries. For a Londoner, it's easier to understand an American than a Cockney. Cockney has a pronunciation, accent and vocabulary unlike any other dialect. Cockney speech is famous for its rhyming slang. A word is replaced by a phrase or a person's name which rhymes with it.

2. Other languages absorb English words too, often giving them new forms and meanings. So many Japanese, French, Spanish and Germans mix English words with their mother tongues that the resulting hybrids are called Japlish, Franglais, Spanglish and Denglish. 4. English is mixing with other languages around the world. It's probably the biggest borrower. Words newly coined or in vogue in one language are very often added to English as well. There are words from 120 languages in its vocabulary, including Arabic, French, German, Greek, Italian, Russian, Spanish and Turkish. 70 per cent of the English vocabulary are loan words and only 30 per cent of the words are native.

5. Have you ever wondered how many people speak English? It's around 400 million people. Geographically, English is the most wide-spread language on earth, and it's second only to Chinese in the number of people who speak it. It's spoken in the British Isles, the USA, Australia, New Zealand and much of Canada and South Africa. English is also a second language of another 300 million people living in more than 60 countries.
